Section 00 20 00, Instruction to Bidders, Article 2, Copies of Bidding Documents, Paragraph 2.01, Bidding Documents, Paragraph A, **REPLACE with:** *Complete bidding documents for this project are available in electronic form. Printed copies of the bid documents are not available from the Engineer or the Owner. Bid documents may be viewed online and downloaded without charge and without deposit from <http://www.mineralcountycolorado.com>. Downloaded files may be printed on the plan holder's equipment. Printed copies may be ordered by contacting a reprographer directly. Plan holders are responsible for their own reproduction costs.*

5. Section 00 50 00, Agreement, Article 3, Engineer, Paragraph 3.01, **REPLACE WITH:** *The Project has been designed by DOWL, 1300 Cedar Street, Helena, Montana 59601.*
6. Section 00 50 00, Agreement, Article 3, Engineer, Paragraph 3.02, **REPLACE WITH:** *The Owner has retained Dibble and Associates ("Engineer") to act as Owner's representative, assume all duties and responsibilities, and have the rights and authority assigned to Engineer in the Contract Documents in connection with the completion of the Work in accordance with the Contract Documents.*
7. Section 00 50 00, Agreement, Article 4, Contract Times, Paragraph 4.02, Contract Times: Days, Paragraphs B, **REPLACE WITH:** *The runway and apron must be open and operational May 27, 2022 through July 5, 2022 and from September 2, 2022 through September 19, 2022. No equipment or materials shall be stored, and no work shall be performed during these time frames within the runway safety areas, taxiway safety areas, apron, or any other area that would impact airport operations. The calendar days during this time will not be counted against the Contract Time.*
8. Section 00 50 00, Agreement, Article 4, Contract Times, Paragraph 4.02, Contract Times: Days, Paragraphs C.1, C.2, and C.3, **Remove:** entire paragraphs.
9. Section 00 50 00, Agreement, Article 4, Contract Times, Paragraph 4.03, Liquidated Damages, Paragraph 4, **REPLACE WITH:** *Contractor shall pay Owner \$10,000.00 in liquidated damages for each day the runway and apron are not open and operational during the time periods described in Paragraph 4.02.B.*
